



## Medical Scientist Training Program

### **MSTP Research Elective (MSTP 5975)**

This course has been designed for MSTP students to enroll for research electives during the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year of medical school. In order to receive credit and stipend while performing a research elective, here are the steps to be followed:

- (1) Four weeks prior to the rotation, a research proposal signed by the research mentor has to be submitted to Kathleen Hansell-Prigg for approval.
- (2) At the end of each 4 week rotation, a lab rotation report has to be submitted to the lab mentor and the MSTP office. Research Rotation Evaluation
- (3) The research mentor submits a research rotation evaluation to the MSTP office within 1 week of the end date. Research Rotation Evaluation
- (4) MSTP Director assigns a grade that is submitted to the Student Affairs office along with the evaluation report within 2 weeks of the end date.

Receives 1 credit for medical school.
